It was founded in 1997 and named after, "Djilali Bounaama", an Algerian nationalist and leader of the Algerian War of Independence. **It includes 19000 students, 20 laboratories, 21 doctoral formations, a FAB-LAB, and an Incubator** The university offers a wide range of undergraduate and graduate programs in various fields, including economics sciences, technology, humanities, social sciences, and languages, Medicine and A.I (The second traing programme in Algeria). providing a high-quality education that prepares students for successful careers and contributes to the development of society. 


KHEMIS MILIANA CITY

Khemis Miliana is located in the province of Aïn Defla in the north-central part of Algeria. The city is about 120 kilometres southwest of Algiers, the capital of Algeria

Khemis Miliana is situated in the Titteri valley and surrounded by the Titteri mountains. Beautiful mountain landscapes surround the city, and it enjoys a mild climate. Khemis Miliana is well-connected to other cities in Algeria, with several major roads and highways running through the city.

The city is also served by a train station, connecting to other cities in Algeria, including Algiers. Facilities in Khemis Miliana Khemis Miliana is a small city, but it offers a variety of facilities and infrastructures to its residents and visitors. The city has several hospitals, clinics, and medical centres that provide quality healthcare to the local population. Khemis Miliana also has a vibrant marketplace where visitors can find a variety of goods, including local handicrafts, clothing, and food. The market is open daily and is a great place to experience the local culture and interact with the friendly people of Khemis Miliana.



DJILALI BOUNAAMA



Djilali Bounaama Si Mohamed, war name, was born on April 16, 1926, in Douar Beni Hendel (Ouarsenis), to a father who was a grocer. Despite not finishing primary school, he worked at the Boucaid zinc mine near Orléansville (Chlef) and became a General Confederation of Labour (CGT) trade unionist. He was also an activist of the Algerian People's Party (PPA), the Mouvement for the Triumph of Democratic Liberties (MTLD), and a member of the Special Organisation (OS). In 1951, he organised the Boucaid miners' strike, which lasted four months. Since the OS was dismantled and he was wanted, he left for Belgium to work in the Borinage coal mines. Upon returning to Algeria, he was arrested on November 6, 1954, and imprisoned in Orléansville, then Barberousse (Algiers). He was released in November 1955 and joined the Algerian army troops in the Ouarsenis massif. Djilali Bounaama played a significant role in the Algerian War of Independence against the French Army from 1954 to 1962. He was the head of the fourth region during the war and became the military chief of Zone 3 of the historical Wilaya 4 in 1957. He became the Commander, an army assistant to Colonel M'Hamed Bougara in late 1958. He took over from Si Salah (Mohammed Zamoum) to lead Wilaya 4 without ever being promoted to colonel.

Djilali Bounaama died on August 8, 1961, in Blida, in the explosion of the villa Naïmi which served as a refuge for the military leaders of Wilaya



What is the admission process for international students?



1. Application:
the student must register on the PROGRES platform, and choose one or more specialisations that match his or her training and career plans. To do this, they must follow the application steps explained below, and then be directed to the Algerian university of their choice.



2. Evaluation:
Once the application is received, the university will evaluate the student's academic qualifications and determine whether they meet the admission requirements for the chosen program of study



3. Language Proficiency:
International students whose native language is not Arabic or French are required to demonstrate proficiency in English by providing a valid language certificate with a minimum of B2 level



4. Admission Decision:
The university will notify the student of his admission decision. If the admission is conditional, the student will need to meet certain requirements, such as providing additional documentation or passing a language proficiency exam, before being fully admitted.



5. Enrollment:
Once admitted, the student will be required to enroll in the university and pay any applicable fees. They may also need to obtain a student visa and satisfy other immigration requirements

What are the admission requirements for the program you're interested in?


For undergraduate programs, admission requirements typically include a high school diploma or equivalent and a certain minimum grade point average. In addition, some programs may require specific courses or prerequisites to be completed before admission. For graduate programs, admission requirements usually include a bachelor's degree or equivalent and a certain minimum grade point average. Some programs may require specific undergraduate courses or prerequisites to be completed before admission.

International students whose native language is not Arabic or French need to demonstrate English proficiency by providing a valid language certificate with a minimum of B2 level. A certificate is also needed if the chosen programme is provided in Arabic or French. It is important to note that admission requirements may vary depending on the program and the University.

Therefore, it is recommended that you visit the University's website or contact the Vice rectorate in charge of External Relations directly to obtain specific information about the admission requirements for the program you are interested in


The University Medicine Service

Students have the right to a safe and secure learning environment, free from harassment, discrimination, or violence


Privacy:
